Classroom Facilities	Chairs, tables, good lighting.

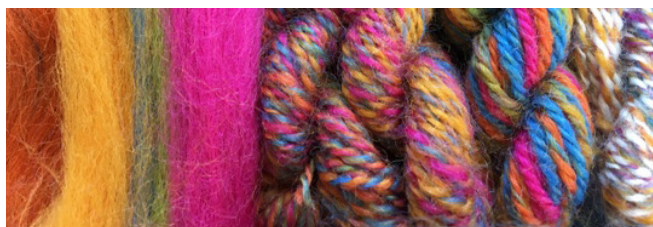
Simple Novelty Yarns
