## Conditions of Entry

**Classes** (for more details please see <https://www.creativefibre.org.nz/canterbury-area-exhibition-2026/>)

**Selected Class:** Entries for this will go through a selection process and are eligible for the sponsored awards. Exhibitors must be current members of Creative Fibre, Canterbury Area. Entry fees: \$10 (\$15 if not for sale).

**Open Class:** Entries into this class will NOT go through the formal selection process. There will be one People's Choice award. One entry per exhibitor who must be a current member of Creative Fibre, Canterbury Area. Entry fee: \$5 (\$10 if not for sale).

**Student Class:** Entries into this class will NOT go through the formal selection process. One entry per exhibitor, who does NOT have to be a member of Creative Fibre but must be enrolled in an educational institution in Canterbury, New Zealand. Items will NOT be made available for sale at the exhibition. \$5 entry fee.

## Entry Process

Entry forms and fees must be submitted by 24 August 2026. The completed items must be brought to Wool, Yarn Fibre, The Tannery Garlands Road, Christchurch between 31 August and 5 September 2026.

**No late entries will be accepted.**

The selection process for the Selected Class, and award judging will take place on 6 September. Only selected articles will be considered when making the awards.

Articles which did not reach a standard to be selected may be collected from Wool Yarn Fibre from 7 -12 September, 10am-4pm. Entry fees will be refunded if your articles are not selected.

Unsold exhibits should be collected from the Pūmanawa Exhibition Space between 3 and 4pm on 27 September or from Wool Yarn Fibre at the Tannery from 29 September - 4 October, 10am -4pm.

Please read all the conditions for the class you enter at the url listed above.

**Please enclose your entry in a clearly named cloth or plastic bag (ie not paper) and attach the packing slip (the last page of this form) to the outside of the bag.**
