

One Two Scarf

Need a simple take-along project? The ends of this attractive scarf are done in a reversible rib-like pattern and the body of the scarf is a rib lace pattern of just two rows.

Materials

Yarn: Worsted weight, 8ply, 228m
Needles: 5mm
Start: Cast on a multiple of 4 stitches, plus 2

One Row

Row 1: *K2, K1tbl, P1. Repeat from * to last 2 sts; K2.
Repeat row 1 until work measures 5cm (2ins)

Two Row

Row 1 (RS) K1, *yf, K2tog tbl; rep from * to last st, K1
Row 2 P1, *yrn, P2tog; rep from * to last st, P1
Repeat Two Row until scarf is as long as you like.

Repeat One Row for another 5cm (2ins). Cast off and weave in ends.

Abbreviations

yf yarn between two needles to forward
yrn yarn round needle. Used to make a stitch between purl stitches
tbl through back loop
